**REQUESTING GENERAL FUND SUPPORT BEYOND
THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH'S 1995-96 BASELINE
BUDGET TO CREATE A SENIOR DISASTER REGISTRY**


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors in the aftermath of the 1989 Loma Prieta earthquake passed a resolution mandating that the Department of Public Health create a senior disaster registry to assist in locating seniors at risk during a disaster; and,

WHEREAS, the recent earthquake in Kobe, Japan underscores the importance of being able to locate and provide assistance to vulnerable people during a disaster; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health must absorb additional costs and reduced revenues totaling \$35 million in its FY 1995-96 budget and cannot reasonably include costs of this local unfunded mandate in addition to other financial obligations; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby respectfully request of the Mayor and Board of Supervisors additional funding as might be required to support the creation of a senior disaster registry and that such funding be in addition to the Department of Public Health's FY 1995-96 baseline budget allocation.
