**DETERMINING WHETHER THE TRANSFER OF CALIFORNIA  
PACIFIC MEDICAL CENTER'S (CPMC) FIVE SENIOR PROGRAMS  
TO ON LOK, INC. WILL OR WILL NOT HAVE A DETRIMENTAL  
IMPACT ON HEALTH CARE SERVICE OF THE COMMUNITY**

WHEREAS, as part of its Strategic Plan, CPMC will transfer five senior programs to On Lok, Inc. effective July 1, 1995; and,

WHEREAS, the five senior programs located at 225 - 30th Street in San Francisco include Adult Day Health, Certified Outpatient Rehabilitation Facility, Senior Center, Day Care for Alzheimer's Patients, and a Nutrition Program; and,

WHEREAS, the 30th Street building would be owned and run by On Lok, Inc., which has a national reputation for its community-based care of the frail elderly and will ensure no disruption in services to participants in the program or to the community; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing, in accordance with the Health Care Planning Ordinance, was held on February 7, 1995, now; therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the Health Commission determines that the CPMC transfer of the five senior programs to On Lok, Inc. will not have a detrimental impact on health care services to the elderly in the community.
