**APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT
OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES,
AND A SUBCONTRACT BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
AND THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA,
THROUGH WHICH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, IN
PARTNERSHIP WITH THE UNIVERSITY WILL BECOME THE PROVIDER
OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION SERVICES FOR CITY EMPLOYEES**

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco issued a competitive bid for a medical treatment site for workers' compensation services for City; and,

WHEREAS, a bid jointly submitted by the Department of Public Health and the University of California was unanimously selected as the best response; and,


WHEREAS, the submission of the bid to become the City's provider of workers compensation services is consistent with the Department of Public Health's strategic direction; and,

WHEREAS, the provision of workers compensation services will result in a new source of revenue for the Department of Public Health and the opportunity to decrease workers' compensation expenditures for all City departments; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed workers' compensation program will facilitate the Department of Public Health's transition to a managed care environment through the development of provider, utilization management, and case management networks; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the San Francisco Health Commission approves the contract between the Department of Public Health and the Department of Human Resources, as well as the subcontract between the Department of Public Health the Regents of the University of California governing the provision of workers' compensation services to City employees.
