RESOLUTION NO. 20-96

**AMENDING THE SAN FRANCISCO ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
BY ADDING THE SAN FRANCISCO GENERAL HOSPITAL
MENTAL HEALTH REHABILITATION FACILITY TRUST FUND**

WHEREAS, pursuant to a bond issue approved by the voters of the City and County of San Francisco, the Department of Health has built a Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility; and,

WHEREAS, SFGH has opened a Skilled Nursing Unit for longer term medical-surgical patients; and,

WHEREAS, the Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility will be licensed as a distinct-part skilled nursing facility and will be added to the license issued by the California Department of Health Services to the City and County of San Francisco for the operation of San Francisco General Hospital; and,

WHEREAS, a licensing requirement of the California Department of Health Services for distinct-part skilled nursing facilities is that a trust fund be established in which funds belonging to or received by patients could be deposited; and,

WHEREAS, the City and County, through San Francisco General Hospital, will be responsible for the proper maintenance, reporting, and accountability of funds deposited by patients at the Medical-Surgical Skilled Nursing Facility and the Mental Health Rehabilitation Facility; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission supports an amendment to the San Francisco Administrative Code which adds Section 10.117-112 to establish in the Treasury of the City and County a special fund to be known and designated as the San Francisco General Hospital Trust Fund, and urges the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor to approve this amendment.
