**APPROVING THE PRIME VENDOR DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM
CONTRACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH**

WHEREAS, the electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed Proposition J in November 1976, adding Section 8.300-1 to the Charter allowing City Departments to contract with private companies for specific services which can be practically performed for a lower cost than similar work by City and County employees; and,


WHEREAS, the Purchaser's Office and Department of Public Health have sought and received various formal bids from private contractors and wish to contract for procurement and distribution of supplies; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health has requested that the Controller's Office certify that said services can be performed at a lower cost to the City and County by private contractors than by employees of the City and County; and,

WHEREAS, contingent upon the Controller's certification that said services can be performed at a lower cost to the City and County by private contractors than by employees of the City and County; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Health Commission approves the Prime Vendor Distribution Program Contract for the Department of Public Health and recommends approval of the contract to the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors.
