CHILD PROTECTION CENTER**

WHEREAS, Ellen Wolfe, RN, PNP, MPH, DrPH dedicated her life to the care and well-being of underserved children and their families; and,

WHEREAS, Ellen Wolfe worked at San Francisco General Hospital for 25 years and served with remarkable effectiveness in numerous roles, including Clinical Nurse Specialist in the Nursery and Nurse Practitioner in the Outpatient Clinic; and

WHEREAS, Ellen Wolfe served as Director of the Early Parenting Project at San Francisco General Hospital, a pioneering child abuse prevention project; and

WHEREAS, Ellen Wolfe was instrumental in creating the Child Protection Center at SFGH and served as the Associate Director for Health Care Services from 1989-2005; and

WHEREAS, Ellen Wolfe created the "Health Passport" system for children in foster care and taught countless foster parents about pediatric health; and

WHEREAS, Ellen Wolfe was a beloved and inspiring health care provider, adept administrator, respected colleague, and treasured friend; and


WHEREAS, Ellen Wolfe was a dedicated faculty member and inspirational teacher in the University of California San Francisco School of Nursing; and

WHEREAS, Ellen Wolfe was an effective and visionary Director of Children's Medical Services for the City and County of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, there is broad support at the San Francisco Child Abuse Prevention Council, San Francisco General Hospital, the University of California, San Francisco School of Nursing, and the San Francisco Department of Public Health to rename the Child Protection Center at SFGH in Ellen Wolfe's memory; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Child Protection Center at San Francisco General Hospital be renamed the Ellen L. Wolfe Child Protection Center.
