PROTECTING A SUSTAINABLE SYSTEM OF CARE DURING ONGOING FISCAL CRISIS

WHEREAS, the mid-year and annual cuts that must be taken are not based on public health needs but on realistic fiscal reality, and

WHEREAS, the Initial Reduction Targets for Departments are not appropriately prioritized across the City,

THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the Commission directs Dr. Katz and his staff to propose a sustainable system of care that meets our financial obligations and reflects the Health Commission and DPH priorities to those most in need in San Francisco.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission is committed to working closely with Dr. Katz, the Mayor, and the Board of Supervisors to Protect this sustainable system of care.
