Resolution No. 16-10**

Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Health, Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center, to accept a gift of merchandise, furniture, fixtures and equipment from Laguna Honda Volunteers, Inc. with a monetary value of up to \$14,000.

WHEREAS, the Laguna Honda Volunteers, Inc. has operated the Green Angels Gift Shop at Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center for many decades; and

WHEREAS, the Laguna Honda Volunteers, Inc. no longer operates the Green Angels Gift Shop, which is now closed; and

WHEREAS, Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center will reopen a gift shop on December 7, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Laguna Honda Volunteers, Inc. is in possession of merchandise, furniture, fixtures, and equipment that is useful to running the hospital's gift shop; and

WHEREAS, Laguna Honda Volunteers, Inc has offered to donate such merchandise to Department of Public Health, Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center; and

WHEREAS, the new gift shop at Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center will make good use of the items; and

WHEREAS, Department of Public Health, Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center wishes to obtain approval from the Health Commission and the Board of Supervisors to accept the donation of the merchandise, furniture, fixtures and equipment; now, therefore; be it

RESOLVED, that the Health Commission approves the acceptance of this gift of \$14,000 comprised of \$2,000 in merchandise and \$12,000 for furniture, fixtures and equipment, in accordance with the requirements set forth pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code Section 10.100-305.
