Resolution No. 17 -10**

RESOLUTION APPROVING RELOCATION OF LAGUNA HONDA HOSPITAL AND REHABILITATION CENTER SERVICES TO THE NEW BUILDINGS AT THE SAME ADDRESS, 375 LAGUNA HONDA BOULEVARD, SAN FRANCISCO, CA 94116.

WHEREAS, Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center plans to relocate its services to new buildings at its current address, 375 Laguna Honda Boulevard, on December 7 and 8, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 1255.25 of the California Health and Safety Code, Laguna Honda is required to post this notice and receive prior approval from the governing board; and

WHEREAS, The relocation is pending issuance of a certificate of occupancy by the Office of Statewide Hospital Planning and Development and approval of the move by the California Department of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, Services to be relocated are: unspecified general acute care; acute rehabilitation; skilled nursing comprised of medical, nursing, laboratory, radiology, pharmacy and dietary services; and a Rehabilitation Center comprised of audiology, occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech pathology; and outpatient services; and

WHEREAS, A total number of patients not exceeding 780 will relocate; and

WHEREAS, Services will cease to be provided in the hospital's current building on December 9, 2010, and will continue uninterrupted in the new buildings; and

WHEREAS, No beds or services will be eliminated in the relocation; and


WHEREAS, There will be no decrease in personnel; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Health Commission approves Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center relocation of services to the new building at the same address, 375 Laguna Honda Boulevard, San Francisco, CA, 94116; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Health Commission hereby forwards the notice of relocation to the San Francisco Board of Supervisors for informational purposes.
