

# San Francisco Fellows Project: Designing a Visual Board for Nursing Huddles

### **Background**

#### San Francisco Fellows Program




San Francisco Fellows are a cohort of recent graduates who are pursuing leadership careers in a public, city-government setting

Fellows are placed as full-time employees with participating city departments and have the option of pursuing a supplemental project for up to 40 hours (Laguna Honda projects have been chosen 2 consecutive years)

## **Project Timeline and Goals**

Goal: To develop a visual communication board to foster problem solving amongst clinical, operations and administrative teams



### **Project Process**

Laguna Honda's proposal was selected by three fellows

- Ariel Bolingbroke: Rec & Park
- Monica Casanova: Public Utilities Commission
- Emily Vontsolos: Controller's Office

To complete the project within the 40 hours timeframe, work was divided into four categories

- Education and overview with project champion: 2 hours
- Interview with stakeholders: 8 hours
- Design and development of electronic huddle board: 20 hours
- Training and implementation: 10 hours

# **Project Challenges**

After interviewing with key stakeholders in the clinical, operations and administrative teams, the fellows identified the major challenges:

- Time limitations: the 40 hours were not consecutive but divided up in biweekly half day sessions
- Organizational structure: operations and administrative teams did not have pre-existing leadership huddles, nor did a visual board sound useful to stakeholders
- Lean experience: clinical (nursing) leaders had significantly more practice using visual tools and standard work for huddling

### Redefining Scope

The team narrowed the scope to overcome the discovered challenges

Old goal: To develop a visual communication board to foster problem solving amongst clinical, operations and administrative teams

New goal: To design a visual communication board that displays information for the daily nursing director huddle

### **Project Deliverables**

- An electronic visual tool that displays patient flow, staffing, medical report, and quality of care metrics that are of "need to know" for nursing leadership on a daily basis
  - This tool will help to:
    - Aggregate data to analyze trends over time
    - Compare data between neighborhoods
    - Ensure discussion during the huddle remains on topic
- The standard work describes how to use the tool and how to make adjustments in the future as new needs arise
  - For example, conditional formatting could be used to identify poor performance requiring immediate attention

#### **Huddle Board in Action**

Follows current flow of daily nursing director huddle and empowers all participants to contribute
