2018 Holly Smith Award Winners

- Direction Setting sessions have started, April 3-5 LHH. Attendance for each of the sessions was tracked to ensure SME attendance for key roles at Direction Setting.
- There will be a total of 240 Sessions with over 500 Subject Matter Experts (SMEs), 350 from ZSFG campus.
- Review of Direction Setting Purpose and Goals
- Overview of EPIC Foundation

Members who attended the sessions expressed appreciation of the well-resourced, organized and thoughtful go-live process conducted by EPIC. Coming up are Direction Settings 2 on April 17-19, and Direction Setting 3 on May 8-10. Dr. Marks and Dr. Pramanik will continue to work on ensuring SMEs attendance in the forthcoming sessions. The presentation also indicated the dates for the Build/Adoption Kickoff (June 4), Adoption Setting Sessions (July 17-19, Aug 14-16, Sept 25-27) and the Workflow Gap Closure (Apr 12 to May 2019).
