

SUMMARY OF CHANGES TO DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHIATRY STANDARDIZED PROCEDURES

Background: The Psychiatry combined standardized procedure covers the following programs under the division of Psychiatry: Acute and Emergency Services, Alliance Health Project, Citywide Case Management, Substance Abuse and Addiction Medicine, Trauma Recovery Services and Jail Behavioral Health Services.

- Updated to read “Buprenorphine, Buprenorphine/Naloxone and Methadone dose induction, adjustment, discontinuation and/or renewal within an Opiate Treatment Program is consistent with State and Federal guidelines.”

Protocol #4 Furnishing Medications

D. Plan, 1) a. iii.

- changed Subutex/Suboxone to generic Buprenorphine, Buprenorphine/Naloxone
- post credentials changed wording to: “practitioners with the DATA-waiver.”

Drug screen changed to specify “urine drug screen to assist with the detection of drugs in urine.
