

## 5.4 Emergency Situations

### 5.4.1 Medical Staff Members and Affiliated Professionals

A. In the event of an emergency, any Member and Affiliated Professional shall be permitted to do everything reasonable to save the life of a patient or to save a patient from serious harm. The Member or Affiliated Professional shall promptly yield such care to a more qualified Member when one becomes available.

B. In the event of an emergency where no Member or Affiliated Professional possesses the expertise necessary to save the life of a patient or to save a patient from serious harm, the Chief of Staff may grant emergency privileges to a licensed physician, with an academic appointment with the University, who possesses the requisite qualifications and expertise to treat the patient.
