DID YOU KNOW...?

Serves more than 13,000 individuals and families annually
Employs 450 faculty and staff
Provides care at ZSFG and four off-campus sites

Psychiatry is the second largest department at ZSFG.

Three of the top 10 Discharge Diagnoses from ZSFG are mental health/substance use disorders. (Schizophrenia/Psychosis, Medical Conditions related directly to drug and/or alcohol use and Depressive Disorder).

Our Division of **Correctional Mental Health** provides psychiatric care to inmates of the SF County jails as well as inmates who need inpatient care at ZSFG.

Our **Behavioral Health Teams** provide support to primary care providers in Medicine and Family Health outpatient clinics. And our **Neuropsychology Service** provides assessments of both inpatients and outpatients, generating data used in helping them to manage their illness and apply for Social Security and other benefits.

Our **HIV/LGBT Mental Health** Division, Alliance Health Project (AHP), provides HIV and Hepatitis C counseling at street fairs, treats clients for selected STD infections with antibiotics "on the spot" and sends them home with "partner packs" to treat exposed partners.

Our **Substance Abuse and Addiction Medicine** Division is one of the three largest providers of methadone treatment for opiate addiction in the city—not only at ZSFG—but also within communities hard hit by opiates by providing methadone dosing from a mobile van.

The **Gender Team** at AHP provides assessments and writes letters in support of gender confirming surgery and one of our psychiatrists is an international expert in Trans mental health care.

Our **Citywide Case Management (CWCM)** Division is the largest case management provider for the chronically and seriously mentally ill in the city.

Our **Infant, Child and Adolescent Division** provides outpatient specialty mental health services for children with significant mental health problems.

We provide services for **children with Eating Disorders.**

Our Division of **Trauma Recovery Services** provides support services for both children and adult victims of violent crimes, including rape and sexual assault, collects forensic evidence for the SFPD, and also counsels refugees and survivors of torture from all over the world.

Our **Psychiatric Emergency Service** is the only dedicated 24/7, **S150 Receiving Facility** in the City and County of SF.

Anyone can purchase food and drinks from ZSFG's "Coffee Cart" and "Hot Dog Cart" operated by CWCM's **Vocational Rehab** Program.

We are SF's largest provider of **acute inpatient psychiatry care.**

Our **Emergency Department Case Management (EDCM)** program provides support to ZSFG's medical emergency room by managing high utilizers of these services.
