PSYCHIATRY CLINICAL SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS 2020

Summary of Changes/Revisions

1. Revisions to section on PSYCHIATRY CLINICAL SERVICE HOUSESTAFF TRAINING PROGRAM regarding PES supervision (p.9).

Psychiatry residents who are providing clinical care during regular business hours 8:00AM-5:00PM are supervised by an attending psychiatrist associated with the individual service. After hours and on weekends, psychiatry residents providing clinical care are supervised by a Back-Up Attending Psychiatrist who provides supervision by telephone and is available to assist on-site as indicated. Psychiatry residents providing clinical care in the Psychiatry Emergency Service (PES) are supervised by a PES attending psychiatrist who is on-site 24/7.

- 1. **ADULT (CORE) PRIVILEGES-PSYCHIATRISTS (MD/DO) to include** placement of all legally applicable involuntary <u>mental health holds</u> for the purpose of evaluation and treatment of patients of <u>all ages (p.10)</u>.
- 2. Revisions to Continuous Monitoring of Clinical Practice/updated and revised metrics

Clinician-specific information for Ongoing Professional Practice Evaluation (OPPE) related to clinical practice is reviewed by the Chief of the department or his/her designee when the staff member is being considered for reappointment to the medical staff. Appropriate information would include the following (p.16):

Attributable/preventable mortality
Peer review completion
UOs about interpersonal and communication skills
Patients' complaints
UOs about professionalism
Chart completion
